Pier Park

Located on the upper deck, between the Crystal Gardens and the Pepsi Skyline Stage is Pier Park. An outdoor landscaped area which features attractions such as a permanent 150-foot-high Ferris wheel, a musical carousel, an old-fashioned swing ride, an 18-hole miniature golf course and more.

Getting to the Venue



From O'hare International Airport

A) Chicago O'Hare International Airport (ORD), 10000 Bessie Coleman Dr, Chicago, IL 60666 US

1. Merge onto I-190 E. (go 3.8 miles)

2. I-190 E becomes I-90 E/Kennedy Expy E. (go 12.44 miles)

3. Take EXIT 50B toward East Ohio St. (go 1.1 miles)

4. Turn right onto N Orleans St. (go 0.11 miles)

5. Take the 2nd left onto W Illinois St. (go 1.31 miles)

6. W Illinois St becomes N Streeter

Dr. (go 0.21 miles)

7. Turn right onto E Grand Ave.

B) Navy Pier, 600 E Grand Ave, Chicago, IL 60611 US

TOTAL ESTIMATED TIME: 31 minutes DISTANCE: 18.98 miles

From Midway International Airport A) Chicago Midway International Airport (MDW), 5700 S Cicero Ave, Chicago, IL 60638 US

1. Start out going south on S Cicero Ave/IL-50 S toward W 59th St. (go 0.23 miles)

2. Take the 1st left onto W 59th St. (go 0.08 miles)

3. Make a U-turn onto W 59th St. (go 0.04 miles)

4. Take the 1st right onto IL-50 N/S Cicero Ave. (go 2.26 miles)

5. Merge onto I-55 N/Stevenson Expy N toward Chicago. (go 7.04 miles)

6. Merge onto US-41 N/S Lake Shore Dr via the exit on the left. (go 3.18 miles)

7. Take the Illinois St ramp toward Grand Ave. (go 0.22 miles)

8. Turn right onto N Streeter Dr. (go 0.21 miles)

9. Turn right onto E Grand Ave.

B) Navy Pier, 600 E Grand Ave, Chicago, IL 60611 US

TOTAL ESTIMATED TIME: 24 minutes DISTANCE: 13.27 miles

Taking the Streets and the GTA

Coming from the South: (I-94/I-57)

Follow I-94 (Dan Ryan Expressway) North. Merge onto I-55 North (toward Lake Shore Drive). Merge left heading North on Lake Shore Drive. Exit Grand Avenue East (Navy Pier).

Coming from the North: (I-94)

Follow I-94 (Edens Expressway) South. Merge onto I-55 North (toward Lake Shore Drive). Merge left heading North on Lake Shore Drive. Exit Grand Avenue East (Navy Pier).

Coming from the West: (I-90)

Follow I-90 (Kennedy Expressway) East. Merge onto I-90/94E. Merge onto I-55 North (toward Lake Shore Drive). Merge left heading North on Lake Shore Drive. Exit Grand Avenue East (Navy Pier).

Coming from the Southwest: (I-55)

Follow I-55 North into Chicago. Merge onto I-55 North (toward Lake Shore Drive). Merge left heading North on Lake Shore Drive. Exit Grand Avenue East (Navy Pier).

Getting to Navy Pier via CTA:

If taking the Red or Blue Line trains, exit Grand Avenue. Take the #65 East to Navy Pier

From Union Station: Take the #124 East to Navy Pier

Tourism around Navy Pier



Millennium Park 201 East Randolph Street

Millennium Park opened in 2004 to quickly become one of Chicago's most popular attractions. Innovative pieces of public art, like Crown Fountain and Cloud Gate, are among Chicago's most recognizable symbols. The Lurie Garden's native prairie landscape comes alive in the summer, while an outdoor ice rink attracts thousands for free skating every winter.

Museum Campus 1200 South Lake Shore Drive

Museum Campus is a 57-acre museum park that sits in front of Lake Michigan and surrounds three of the city's most notable museums: the Adler Planetarium, the Shedd Aquarium, and the Field Museum of Natural History. It is also known for holding Soldier Field and the Lakeside Center of the McCormick Place.





The Magnificent Mile 900 North Michigan Avenue

Chicago's Magnificent Mile is one of the great avenues of the world and is at the center of all that makes Chicago an international destination.
