



Venue & Staff Hotel

Venue: Vancouver Convention Centre 1055 Canada Place Vancouver, BC V6C 0C3 (604) 689-8232

Staff Hotel: Vancouver Marriott Pinnacle Downtown 1128 West Hastings Street Vancouver, BC V6E 4R5 (604) 684-1128 \$159 per night - accommodates two, \$30 per additional person after



Directions

Airport to Hotel:

-Transit- Fare \$9 peak (\$7.75 offpeak) - Trip time 30 mins.

- 1) Take the Canada Line Skytrain from YVR/Airport Station to Waterfront Station (2 zones red button).
- 2) Exit Waterfront Station via the Granville Street exit.
- 3) Walk north to the intersection of Granville and Hastings.
- 4) Turn left on Hastings and walk 4 blocks to Thurlow Street.
- 5) Mariott Pinnacle is on the corner of Hastings and Thurlow.

-Car/Taxi- Taxi fare \$35

- 1) Leave YVR via Grant McConachie Way and follow it over the Arthur Laing Bridge where it will become Marine Drive (Highway 99).
- 2) After a short distance Marine Drive will dump you onto Granville Street (still Highway 99).
- 3) Keep following Granville, after about 8.5 miles (13.5 km) you'll arrive at the Granville Street Bridge.
- 4) On the far side of the bridge keep right and exit onto Seymour Street.
- 5) Follow Seymour Street about 9 blocks and turn left onto Pender Street.
- 6) Mariott Pinnacle is on Pender on your right about 5 blocks from Seymour. Find a place to park.

Greyhound/Train Station to Hotel:

-Transit- Fare \$2.75

- 1) Exit the terminal and cross the courtyard to Main Street/Science World Skytrain.
- 2) Take the train heading to Waterfront Station for 3 stops to Burrard Station.
- 3) Exit Burrard Station to Burrard Street and turn left (north) on Burrard.
- 4) Walk 2 blocks down Burrard to Pender Street and turn left. The Mariott Pinnacle is one block ahead on your rightt.

Hotel to Venue:

-Walk-

- 1) Exit Mariott Pinnacle on Thurlow and Hastings.
- 2) Walk 2 blocks north down Thurlow towards the water.
- 3) The Convention Centre is right there.

Directions (cont.)

US Border (Peace Arch Crossing) to Hotel:

-Car-

- 1) I-5 becomes Highway 99 once you pass through customs.
- 2) Follow Highway 99 through the Deas Island Tunnel.
- 3) Follow it over the Oak Street Bridge.
- 4) Highway 99 continues on Southwest Marine Drive after the bridge so keep right and take the cloverleaf exit that goes there.
- 5) Follow Marine Drive until it dumps you onto Granville Street (still Highway 99).
- 6) Keep following Granville, after about 8.5 miles (13.5 km) you'll arrive at the Granville Street Bridge.
- 7) On the far side of the bridge keep right and exit onto Seymour Street.
- 8) Follow Seymour Street about 9 blocks and turn left onto Pender Street.
- 9) Mariott Pinnacle is on Pender on your right about 5 blocks from Seymour. Find a place to park..

US Border (Truck Crossing) to Hotel:

- -Car-
 - 1) After passing customs, you'll be on Highway 15 (176th Street).
 - 2) Follow Highway 15 about 12 miles (19 km) until you reach Highway 1.
 - 3) Take Highway 1 West, crossing the Port Mann Bridge and after about 10 miles (16 km) from the bridge you'll want to take the Hastings Street exit.
 - 4) Turn left onto Hastings and follow it right downtown.
 - 5) Mariott Pinnacle is at Hastings and Thurlow.

Food

There are plenty of food options within a short walk of the hotel and venue. Many of the options below are less than a 15 minute jaunt from either location. There are a few places that are further than that, still in Vancouver, but are mentioned because they're worth checking out.



One such place is the Storm Crow Tavern (<u>http://www.stormcrowtavern.com/</u>) which is a 10 minute taxi ride from downtown. The owner, Jason Kapalka, has kindly offered a 10% "Magic" discount for days before,

during and after the Grand Prix to judges that present their judge name tag.
