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1. Useful information upon arrival

Porto Alegre, the capital of the Brazilian state of the Rio Grande do Sul, is located in the southern region of the country. Its name means "joyful harbour". Its population is 1.509.939 inhabitants. With an area of almost 500 square kilometers, it has a diversified geography, with hills, lowlands and a large lake, the Guaiba.

1.1. Currency exchange

The local currency is the real (R\$). One real is equal to one hundred centavos.

US dollars and other currencies are not commercially used. International credit cards are accept, Mastercard and Visa in almost every place.

The current conversion of US Dollars to Brazilian Real is USD 1 to R\$ 3,19.

Exchange only the amount you plan to spend, since is impossible or expensive exchange back (depending the currency exchange house). It's possible find people exchanging money on the streets, though they might at times offer you a better price than currency exchange houses, avoid making transactions with these people, since this is exchanging in the black market (there's a risk of getting scammed).

1.3. Visa

Brazil maintains a fully reciprocal visa policy, which means that visa is mandatory only for citizens of countries that obligate visa to Brazilians. In case of mandatory visa, visitors must obtain a visa in one of the Brazilian diplomatic missions. Brazilian visa will never be granted in Brazilian territory, therefore they must necessarily be obtained through the Embassies, General Consulates, Consulates and Vice consulates of Brazil abroad. To apply for a visa, foreigners must submit the visa application form, a valid travel document, proof of payment of consular fees and other specific documents for the type of visa requested.

1.4. Language and communication

The official language of Brazil is Portuguese, spoken by the entire population. English is not widely spoken, except in some tourist areas, and neither is spanish. Some places like hotels may understand if you speak English or Spanish. In case of taking a bus or a taxi, it may be a good idea to write down the address or station you wish to go.

1.4. Electricity

Brazil uses both 110 and 220 volts and the frequency is 60Hz. It uses the following types of socket: A, B, C, I, N (introduced in 2010, only newer buildings have it).

1.5. Smoking

Smoking is forbidden in closed places (public or private), such as restaurants, stores, shopping malls, building lobbies, airports, etc.

1.6. Weather

Porto Alegre has a humid climate. The average annual temperature is 19°C.

- Winter (June to September): between -1°C e 19°C.
- Summer (December to March): between 20°C e 38°C.
- Fall (April to June): between 7°C e 25°C.
- Spring (September to November): between 10°C e 30°C.



2. Airports and getting to the city

There is one airport in Porto Alegre, Salgado Filho (code: POA). Flights come from and go to cities such as São Paulo, Rio de Janeiro, Belo Horizonte, Brasília, Curitiba, Florianópolis, Foz do Iguaçu, Montevideo, Córdoba, Rosario, Buenos Aires, Santiago de Chile, Lima, Panama City, Miami and Lisboa. It is served by all major Brazilian airlines (Azul, Avianca, GOL, LATAM), regional ones (NHT and Trip) and international airlines TAP Portugal, COPA, TACA, and Aerolineas Argentinas.

Hand luggage

The hand luggage can not exceed 23 x 40 x 55 cm. The weight should not exceed 5kg. Except for children under two years, each passenger can carry the following as hand luggage: a purse or briefcase that can be placed under the seat, a blanket, an umbrella, reading material, a small camera or laptop. The following objects are not allowed in hand luggage: any kind of drink, shampoos, fragrances, lotions, liquid cosmetics, hair spray, toothpast, deodorant (aerosol, liquid or cream, matches and lighters whose fuel is gas type torch. Taxi (indicated):

You will find two types of taxis by the airport: the white ones and the red ones. The red cabs are the usual cabs you find around the city. The white cabs service only the airport and they used to be more expensive. If you do not know your way around the city, it is more advised to take the white cabs.

Train

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There is an "airtrain" connecting the airport to the train station from 10AM **PORIO** to 4PM. Once in the station, you can buy the tickets and board the "Mercado" bound trains.

 - Drop off in the last station (Mercado). The last station is in downtown Porto Alegre. The distance between this station and the downtown is 1,6 km. There are taxis near the station.
- To near the venue:
 - The venue is not near the stations.

Bus

 - The bus options require walking to the stops and last more than 1 hour. In general, for this route two buses are needed. One of the options is to walk to Sertorio avenue, take the bus 727, drop off after 33 stops.

3. Moving around in the city



Bus

The bus fare is R\$ 3,75 and must be paid to the "cobrador" before crossing the turnstile located inside the bus. Fares may be paid either in cash or using a smartcard system named TRI. However to get your TRI Card you need to be a Porto Alegre citizen since you need a proof of living in Porto Alegre in order to get your card.


The app Moovit can be useful too. It shows the route and the necessary transportation to get to a destination.



Train/Metro

Trains serve only the metropolitan area. Locals can call it "trensurb" and services are limited, with only one line connecting downtown to some metropolitan cities (Canoas, Esteio, Sapucaia do Sul, São Leopoldo, and Novo Hamburgo). The fare is R\$1,70.

Taxi

The fare starts at R\$ 5,18 and then R\$ 2,59 every 1 kilometer (or R\$ 3,36 between 8PM and 6AM). The fare must be paid always in reais. Not all the taxis accept cards, so you have to ask the driver. There might be a very small surcharge for luggage. The app "**Easy taxi**" can help to ride a cab. In this app you have to input your address and the form of

payment, then a cab near will accept the job. You also

can ask at the hostel to call a taxi for you.

9. Useful tips

Following tips for safety in Porto Alegre:

At any time, avoid poor areas (you can see a map here:

https://portoimagem.wordpress.com/2011/12/29/mapa-com-a-localizacao-das-vilas-favelas-deporto-alegre/poafavela/) and watch out for pickpockets within the Historic Centre, particularly on rua dos Andradas (also known as rua da Praia) and near the bus station — watch your backpack, pockets and wristwatch.

After the sunset, you should stay away from:

- Marinha park
- Harmonia park
- Farropilha park (also know as Redenção)
- Praça Conde de Porto Alegre
- Conceição tunnel and under Conceição viaduct
- the surroundings of the Police Palace (Palácio da Polícia) police station, at avenida Ipiranga and avenida João Pessoa
- The red light district on rua Voluntários da Pátria

Because not many Brazilians report crime to authorities, it is recommended that you check this crime map:
