


Welcome To Phoenix Sky Harbor Airport

Like most locations, your transportation options are plentiful, and due to the venue being a glorious five and a half miles from the airport, these are my best suggestions:

Public Transportation: \$2.00 & about 30 minutes

- Ask a lovely information person (generally elderly and wearing a purple PHX shirt) where the nearest sky train station is in your terminal and go there.
- The Sky Train is free; you do not need a ticket to board
- Take the Sky Train toward the 44th/Washington Valley Metro Station
- Get off at the last stop and find your way to the West Bound Light Rail station ***
 you will need to purchase a \$2 one-way ticket at a kiosk ***
- Board the Train and enjoy the ride you'll get off at the 3rd St and Washington Stop and the venue is just north of the stop, on 3rd St



You can also plan you trip on trips.valleymetro.org if going to your hotel.

Transportation Continued...

Uber/Lyft:



Between \$10 – \$15 and 15 – 25 minutes (traveling between 7am – 9am and 3pm – 6pm may increase the time and cost of your trip)

 Each terminal has designated pick-up locations, be sure to select the closest one to you when requesting your ride

Super Shuttle:




\$13+ for a shared shuttle ride using discount code HTW6H at booking.supershuttle.com, time to arrival dependent on other rider sand drop off sequence

- Purchase your ticket in advance using the website above
- The super shuttle counters are often near baggage claim, but if you have trouble locating them, ask one of the lovely information people in the purple shirts
- The Super Shuttle staff will further guide you on where to wait and when you shuttle is ready for you be sure to tip your driver!

Phoenix Convention Center

Phoenix convention center is large and expands on three of the four corners at the Washington and 3rd Street intersection.

Hilton Phoenix Suites 10 E Thomas Rd Phoenix, AZ 85012

*** This is a few miles from the venue but easy access via light rail for only \$2 per ride or \$4 per day.

- To get to the venue, board the light rail on Central going south, and get off at 3rd St and Jefferson.
- To get back to the hotel you board going west/north and get off at Central and Thomas.

Open daily from 10am – 5pm Tickets are \$18 per adult IMAX experiences are about \$9 each Purchase tickets at azscience.org




